What can I buy through Everything ICT?

- ✓ Hardware such as PCs, laptops, tablets, servers, multi-functional devices and interactive and passive AV boards.
- ✓ Software such as MIS, Finance, Budgeting, HRIS, Payroll, Safeguarding, Assessment software, Parent Engagement software, Microsoft Office 365, and Google.
- ✓ Internet connectivity such as broadband, dedicated lines, 4G, 5G and Starlink. Infrastructure such as WIFI, cabling, wide area networks and network management.
- ✓ Cloud services, including cloud hosting, AI, cybersecurity software, filtering, automated backup services, remote desktop, disaster recovery, internet-based telephony systems (VoIP).

How do I buy through Everything ICT?



Step 1 – Tell us what you want

If you know exactly what you need – great. If not, we're happy to offer recommendations and help you scope your request.



Step 2 – We help you select the best supplier for your requirements

We can quickly gather multiple quotes from different suppliers on your behalf. You'll get a clear, online quote to review.

If your requirements are complex or you want to ensure the best value for money, we can run a mini-competition tailored to your specific needs.



Step 3 – Sign and raise a purchase order

Once you're happy with the quote or outcome of the competition, let us know. You then raise a Purchase Order and confirm it with us.



Step 4 – The supplier delivers

The chosen supplier provides the goods or services in line with the agreed specifications and pricing. Delivery dates are confirmed in advance, and installation or setup (where required) is carried out as planned.



Step 5 – Invoicing

We send you an invoice referencing your Purchase Order. Once you confirm you're happy with what's been delivered, you complete payment.



Step 6 – Ongoing support

If there is an issue with an order, Everything ICT continues to support customers after the procurement has been completed. Our [helpdesk](#) can help resolve queries with the relevant supplier and keep things moving.

What if my trusted supplier isn't on the list?

Easy, ask them to contact suppliers@everythingict.org and we'll send them a sign-in to an online application process. If they pass our evaluation process, they will join our approved supplier list (see below). On occasion, we can do this at pace so they can join your mini competition.



How does Everything ICT select suppliers?

Any supplier can apply to join Everything ICT's approved supplier list. There is no fee for them to join, but there is a rigorous evaluation process that tests, among other things, that they comply with all the usual Public Sector requirements (e.g. DBS checks, GDPR, Modern Slavery). They must also sign up to certain terms and conditions, including that customers must not be able to buy direct from the supplier.



Who can use our services?

Why do I pay Everything ICT and not the supplier?

Your contract is with us, not the supplier. We do this to ensure your procurement is compliant and to provide protection to you. We don't pay suppliers until you sign off that you are happy. If something goes wrong with that supplier, it's our responsibility to sort it out on your behalf.

How do you ensure value for money?

- Suppliers must agree that **customers cannot buy cheaper directly** from them, guaranteeing best value through Everything ICT.
- **National agreements with major suppliers** provide reduced pricing, negotiated for maximum value.
- Thousands of orders each year enable **benchmarking and price comparisons** to keep costs competitive.
- Like-for-like testing of specifications ensures you get the **best price on equipment** that meets your needs.
- The Everything ICT procurement service is **free to customers**, with costs covered by suppliers — meaning you save on every purchase.



Who are WCL (UK)?

WCL (UK) is the registered name of the limited company that runs our procurement service and is the neutral vendor on the frameworks we operate. When the company was set up in 2011, we didn't know we would have such a high-profile role, otherwise we would have picked a better name. While we trade as Everything ICT (for obvious reasons) we invoice and will show in your finance systems as WCL (UK).



Why can I sometimes find things cheaper on Google, Amazon or ebay?

Often there are sensible reasons like: it's not a like-for-like specification; it comes without a warranty; it's end-of-range, or there are limited volumes. Value for Money is defined in the DfE Buying Guidance as more than about price; quality and service are also important factors to take into consideration. And if you buy from these other sources we can't help when things go wrong.
